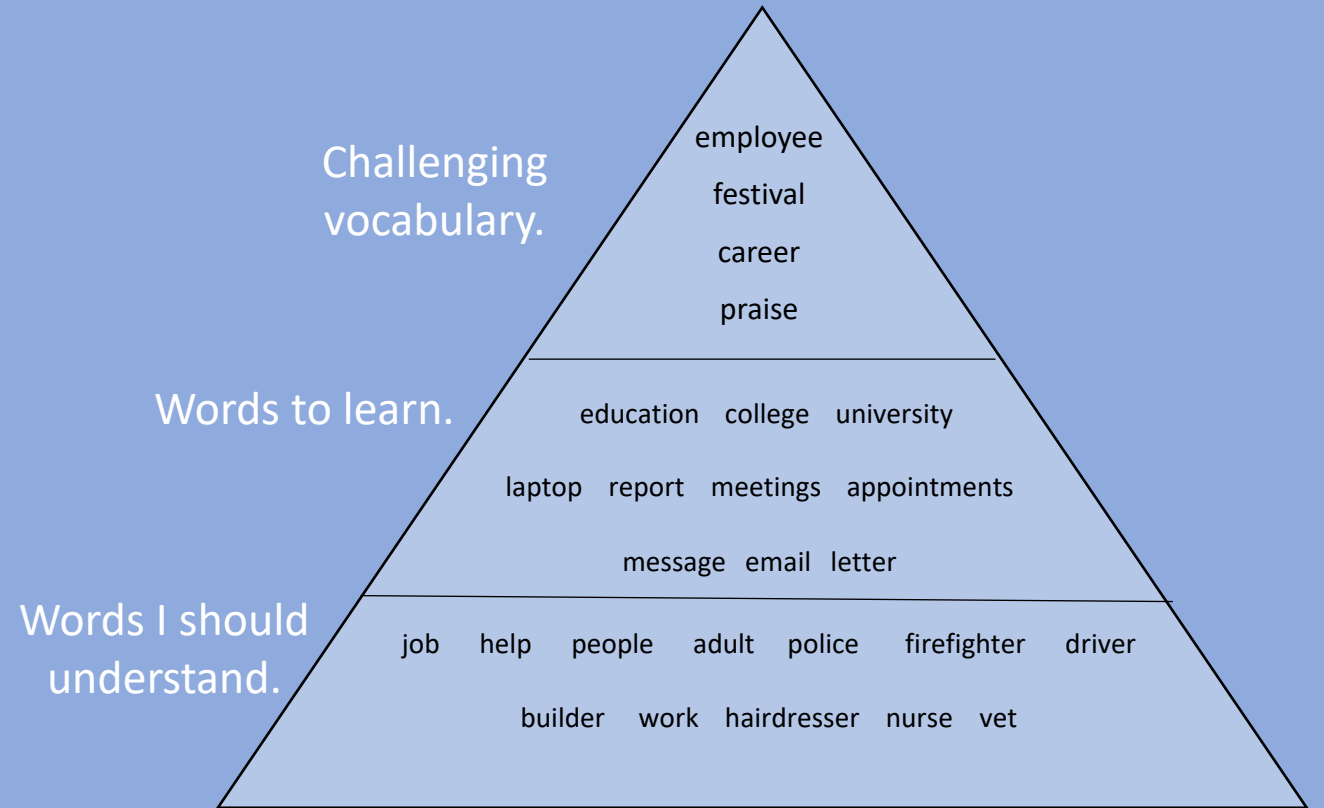
What jobs do people do around us?
