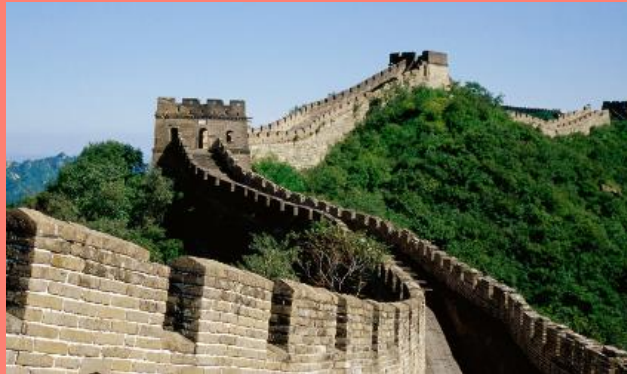
Here are some fabulous facts about our topic Tremendous China!
