Objectives of Sports Premium Spending

Key principles:

- To improve the quality of existing PE teaching through continuing professional development in PE for generalists, so that all primary pupils improve their health, skills and physical literacy, and have broader exposure to a range of sports.
- To increase participation levels in competitive sport and healthy activity of pupils, and maintain these into adolescence.
- To increase the quality of initial teacher training in PE and sport, and to promote PE specialisation in primary level workforce.
- To ensure that schools understand and value the benefits of high quality PE and sport, including its use as a tool for whole school improvement.

The Impact of the Sports Premium grant this year:

- EYFS have made progress in ABC skills of agility, balance and coordination through receiving quality physical activity weekly from Derbyshire Yoga Bugs.
- A large number of pupils joining in with 'The Golden Mile' fitness initiative -almost half of the children have attended and a third attends every week. Several children have reached milestones of 50 & one of 75 miles!
This has really promoted fitness and has improved the children's fitness levels and stamina.
- Increased participation (and some success) in competitive school sport; a wide range of competitions have been entered & the teams have had some success- runners up in the Sports hall Athletics & qualifying for the Boys (5/6) Cross Country regional competition (& 2 individuals).
- The new PE scheme is providing support for teachers in differentiation and progression. It has plans which have enabled staff to try new sports.
- The Sport's Crew have received training in the form of a 'Change for Life' conference and also training in specific skills (reporting, photography etc) on the 'Bronze Ambassadors Training day.
- Midday training in 'Change for Life' also.
- Class 3 were able to take part in a collaborative & creative PE activity by attending The Cluster Dance Festival for the first time.
- Whole school were able to participate in Curriculum enrichment African Dance Workshop.
