# Objectives of Sports Premium Spending

## Key principles:

- To improve the quality of existing PE teaching through continuing professional development in PE for generalists, so that all primary pupils improve their health, skills and physical literacy, and have broader exposure to a range of sports.
- To increase participation levels in competitive sport and healthy activity of pupils, and maintain these into adolescence.
- To increase the quality of initial teacher training in PE and sport, and to promote PE specialisation in primary level workforce.
- To ensure that schools understand and value the benefits of high quality PE and sport, including its use as a tool for whole school improvement.

### A summary of the impact of the Sports Premium grant this year:

- EYFS have made progress in ABC skills of agility, balance and coordination through receiving quality physical activity weekly from Derbyshire Yoga Bugs and from 'Wheely Good Fun' Balance Bikes.
- The specialist Basketball Coaching was a success with children, who learnt a lot & were able to compete well in our Cluster Competition (Runners up!) Staff also felt that it improved their skills & ability to teach Basketball well in the future.
- Pupils who attend Breakfast Club/After-school club have outdoor/ physical activities to participate in at all times. This has really promoted fitness and has improved the children's fitness levels and stamina.
- Increased participation (and some success) in competitive school sport; a wide range of competitions have been entered & the teams have had some success- runners up in the Basketball & some good individual performances in Cross Country.
- The Sport's Crew have received training in the form of a 'Change for Life' conference and also training in specific skills (reporting, photography etc) on the 'Bronze Ambassadors Training day. They are becoming more confident in running activities at lunchtime and taking more ownership over the activities. The lunchtimes are becoming more structured with activities promoting active lunchtimes.
- The hire of the Sport's Hall (Places for People) has enabled the children in Upper Key Stage Two to access greater space for PE lessons and better gymnastic equipment – meaning they have a better quality PE session.
