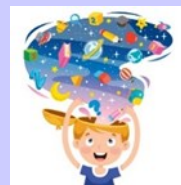

Encourage relationships based on kindness, respect and understanding of the needs of others.

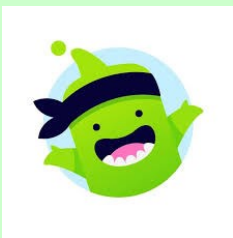

What happens if I break the rules?

|---------------------|---|
| First warning | The supervising adult will give me a verbal remind- er of the rule(s) I have broken. |
| Second warn- ing | If the behaviour continues, this will result in 5 minutes play time lost. |
| Reflection time | Continuation of behaviour will result in loss of breaktime with the restorative worksheets (at the bottom of this policy) |
| Final warning | If this behaviour continues you will be sent to the Headteacher or a different class teacher. |



Red

If a child receives a red card, the class teacher will contact the parents to discuss their child's behaviour.

Parents will be contacted by a member of staff in the event of a serious breach of the school rules in order to discuss the incident and work together to support improvements in the behaviour of the child.

Instant red zone offenses

Fighting, verbal aggression, swearing, spitting.
